We are always in need of volunteers throughout the year. If you're interested in volunteering this year, please check all that may apply.

Vision & Hearing Screening- help screen all students with the districts annual vision and hearing screening. Commitment is approx. from 7:45am-11:00am and this year it's on Tuesday, Oct 2nd.
